



How to get to Skydive Nagambie

Kirwans Bridge - the most popular route to the Skydive Nagambie dropzone - will be closed to traffic until mid-June 2004 as it undergoes extensive maintenance.

Here's another way to Skydive Nagambie...

From Melbourne:

Make your way to Nagambie - but don't drive all the way into town.

Shortly after the 70km/h sign, there is a United Petroleum Station.

Take that left turn (Route C344 to Heathcote) and reset your odometer to zero.

Once heading to Heathcote...

After 2.5km, you'll drive over a bridge. No stopping, fishing or jumping at the bridge.

At the 3.7km mark, there's a right hand turn to Rushworth. Turn right here and follow your nose for a bit.

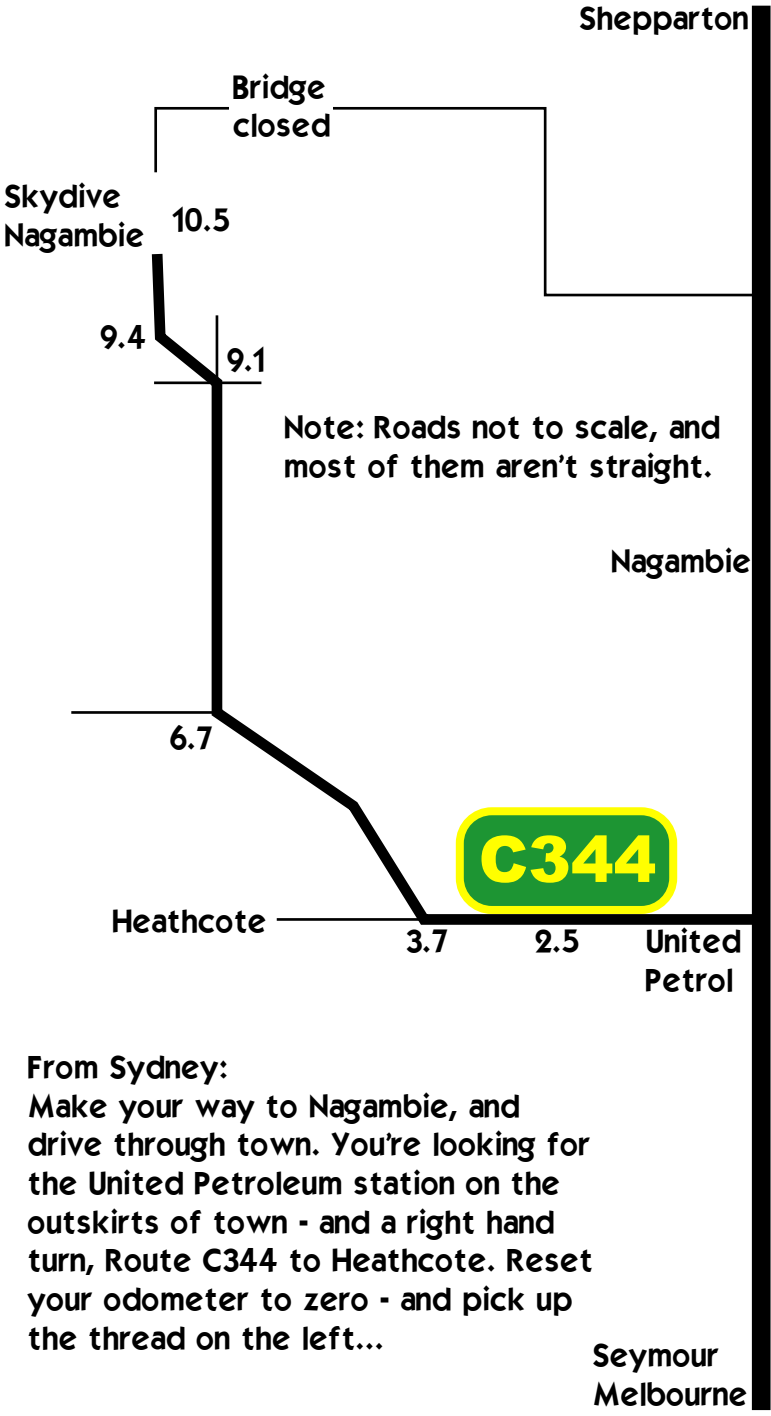
At 6.7km, there's another right hand turn which takes you onto an unsealed road. Roadworks here, so take it easy.

At 9.1km, there's a four way intersection. Go as straight ahead as you can (Reedy Lake Road), although the main road veers to the left as you cross the intersection.

At 9.4km, turn right towards the Parachute Centre, back onto sealed road. Keep an eye out for Joe's freebag, out here somewhere.

The speed limit reduces to 60 as you approach the left turn into the dropzone, which is at the 10.5km mark.
